### **Outreach Programs**

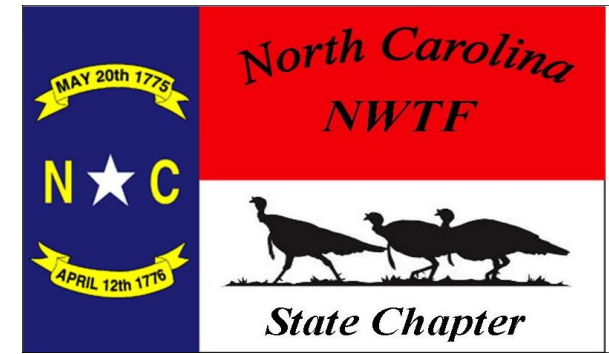
*Over \$32,000 spent on outreach programs such as Wheelin, WITO and Jakes*
